It is a requirement of Regulation 6, of the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations that an assessment of health risks created by work involving substances hazardous to health is undertaken by the employer. To raise the awareness of delegates in respect of their responsibilities under the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health [COSHH] Regulations.

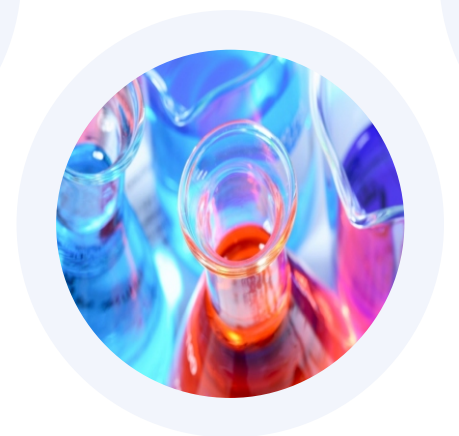
