The NEBOSH National General Certificate is recognised as the standard qualification in health and safety for the non-safety specialist. OMS have an excellent pass rate of above 90% on this course, which is consistently higher than the national average.

Duration

12 Days - including revision and exams.

Who should attend

Non-specialists in health and safety who require sound initial training leading to a recognised qualification through examination and assessment.

Aims and objectives

On successful completion of the course, candidates will be able to:

- Identify the common hazards likely to be found in the workplace and advise on appropriate control measures
- Advise on appropriate action to minimise fire risks and assist in the development of procedures to deal with fires
- Assist in the preparation, review and monitoring of safety policies and procedures including pro-active and reactive strategies, training audits and safety committees
- Investigate accidents and other incidents, prepare reports making cost effective proposals to prevent re-occurrences
- Identify the main requirements of legislation and codes of practice
- Undertake workplace inspections and recommend cost effective remedial action
- Suggest appropriate changes to work systems and environments that will lead to improvements in health, safety and welfare
- Describe the effects of human and organisational factors on health and safety
- Specify the health and safety training needs of person[s] at work
- Describe the health and safety information to be displayed in the workplace
- Identify sources of guidance and advice on health and safety

Two written examinations and one practical assessment with a written report.

Certification

The examinations are assessed and moderated by NEBOSH. Certificates are issued to successful candidates.
