

SPA Passport to Safety

[PTS] Food & Drink Sector Module



The course is designed for managers and employees of contractors to provide basic safety training prior to entering premises operating the 'Passport to Safety' scheme. One day of basic training [Core Day] is followed up by 1 day of sector-specific training [Food & Drink Industry].

Duration

One day [plus the PTS Core Day prior to attending this course].

Who should attend

All persons who are required to enter a site operating the Safety Passport scheme and are involved in food industry premises work. Candidates already possessing the CCNSG Safety Passport only have to complete the Sector-Specific Day.

Aims and objectives

Develop the delegate's awareness of health and safety issues related to working on Food and Drink premises. To ensure that they understand the main hazards associated with this type of workplace.

Content

- Food protection
- Environmental protection
- Health and Safety in the food sector
- Transport
- Electricity

Assessment Method

Multi-choice question papers.

Certification

The programme is assessed and moderated by SPA. Safety Passports are issued to successful candidates.
